#### Call to Order

Chair Torres called the meeting to order at 12:05 p.m. A quorum was present.

Chair Torres introduced Ms. Stephanie Howell, Assistant Vice President, Community Affairs and Economic Development, who will serve as the President's appointed designee.

# **College President's Report**

Dr. Plinske reported summer enrollment is up and trending the same as fall enrollment.

She noted that the State budget has not yet been finalized.

Dr. Plinske stated that the College was able to secure private contributions to support scholarships for every graduating senior from Evans and Jones High Schools, with special thanks to the college's partnership with Lift Orlando. The scholarship was announced at the high schools on April 9, 2025. Dr. Plinske shared a video.

# **Executive Director's Report**

Ms. Thomas reported that the Foundation's fiscal year runs April 1 – March 31, with fundraising projections over 4 million in cash and pledges. The goal for this fiscal year is \$4.25 million.

She noted that President's Circle memberships grew from 153 to 174, a 14% increase.

Ms. Thomas thanked Chair Torres and Walt Disney World for a \$100,000 gift for VCentials and Director Arroyo for a gift of \$50,000 from Duke Energy.

In fiscal year 2024-2025, the foundation awarded \$1.6 million in scholarships to 2,041 students.

# **Chief Financial Officer's Report**

Mr. Cristancho reported that last fiscal year was a success. He noted the team is working with the consultant on the 990 and year-end close.

He expects closing assets for the Foundation to total \$120 million, driven by investments managed by SEI.

Despite a volatile year, the Foundation ended in a strong position, with a slightly positive return for the quarter.

Operating revenue and expenses are also positive.

Vice-Chair Nominee Director Rambeau moved to approve the nomination of

Director Jeff Mock to serve as Vice Chair of the Board. Director Nicholas seconded the motion, and the motion was

approved unanimously.

**Board Governance** Chair Torres reported that she, Ms. Thomas,

Mr. Mullowney, and Mr. Cristancho attended the AGB

Foundation Leadership Forum.

Chair Torres noted the Foundation is on the right path with its current strategic plan. She noted a need to review and enforce Board term limits. She shared that outreach has begun, as 13 members currently have expired terms.

**Presentation from AGB**Margaret Jarrell Cole of AGB gave a presentation on

effective board governance and fund management.

Red, Black and Boundless Gala Ms. Thomas shared that the Red, Black and Boundless Gala

will be held on Saturday, September 13, 2025 at Walt Disney World's Epcot ShowPlace Pavilion. She encouraged board members to participate through

sponsorships and the silent auction.
